## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS GOVERNING ALL CWDGA EVENTS

The Rules of Golf as approved by **THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION** and **THE R&A Rules Limited** governs all CWDGA competitions as supplemented by the conditions of the competition established by the CWDGA and set forth below. Each player is responsible for knowing the Rules and conditions of the competition and should carry a copy of *The Rules of Golf* and the conditions of play for reference.

Refer to the **Instructions Governing Tournament Play** for specific information relating to tournament play, and to the **Instructions Governing Four-Ball Match Play** for specific information relating to team match play.

1. **The Committee:** **The Committee** is the CWDGA and is represented at all competitions by the uniformed CWDGA officials present at the competition. Host-club officers and personnel are not members of the Committee.

2. **Handicaps:** Handicap records received by the CWDGA from the USGA Handicap System are used for all competitions.

3. **Club Representation:** Competition in all events is limited to eligible players from CWDGA member clubs. A player who may be a member of more than one club shall select the club that she shall represent in all CWDGA competitions and shall not be permitted to make any change during the year unless permission is granted by the CWDGA Board of Directors.

4. **Local Rules:** All Local Rules of the club hosting the competition that are printed on the club's scorecard are adopted for the competition unless otherwise posted in writing by the Committee.

5. **Attire:** Players and caddies must be properly attired on both the golf course and the premises of the club. Jeans of any color, T-shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Collared shirts are strongly suggested and shorts and golf skirts must be mid-thigh in length. This dress code is in effect at all CWDGA events in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the site hosting the event. It is always advisable to consult the host-club for clarification of policies.

6. **Slow Play:** Pursuant to USGA Rule 6-7, the CWDGA has established the following pace of play guidelines. A group of four players is expected to take no more than 15 minutes per hole – **4 hours and 30 minutes per round** to play. Any group that fails to hold its position on the course will be alerted and requested to play at a faster pace. After being warned, the group will be monitored. The time each player takes to play each stroke will be recorded. Any player in a group out of position that takes more than 45 seconds to play a stroke on two occasions will be advised of that fact and told that if she exceeds the time limit on two more shots, she will incur the **penalty** provided in Rule 6-7.
