Message from the Handicap Chair



Welcome to the new season of golf in the Chicago District! After a long winter I know that everyone will soon be busy perfecting their golf games and hopefully improving their Handicap Indexes! Just a reminder that those who play golf in an area observing an active season (i.e.,

Florida, Arizona, California, etc.) must post your scores for handicap purposes. This is true even if the golf club from which you receive your Handicap Index (your Chicago-area club) is observing an inactive season – as we are here in Chicago!

This will be the second year of the Chicago District Golf Association (CDGA) Handicap Information System. Although most of the changes took place last season, this past winter a change in the system now allows a player to keep a Handicap Index that is up to date on a year-round basis by providing handicap revisions during the inactive season.

Handicaps for the Chicago Women's District Golf Association are kept in accordance with the USGA Handicap System, administered through the CDGA. All CWDGA member clubs must use the handicap information services through associate membership with the CDGA. This assures uniformity in handicaps throughout the District.

Again this year the CDGA Handicap Information System is in line with the handicap calendar of the USGA whereby the handicap revisions take place on the 1st and 15th of every month throughout the calendar year. However, we will still observe an active season – and the first day of posting scores will be April 1, 2011 and the final day for posting scores will be October 31, 2011.

If you should have any questions throughout the season regarding handicap matters, please do not hesitate to contact me. Thank you for your help in assuring that our handicap system is properly administered!

TOURNAMENT NEWS



Our 2011 tournaments promise to be exciting as well as challenging. Two of the tournament courses were renovated in 2006 to confront the skills of serious players and one has a history of prestigious golf professionals.

Our tournament season begins with the **One-Day Stroke** tournament to be played

at Oak Park Country Club on Wednesday, May 25th.

Designed by the legendary Donald Ross and Richard

Jacobson, Oak Park CC in River Grove, IL has a long and
interesting history since it opened in 1914. Horton Smith, who
won the first Masters Tour in 1935 (and the third in 1936),
was the golf professional at Oak Park CC during the time he
won those tournaments. Interestingly, at age 100, he is the
only surviving player from that first Masters Tournament.

A second Masters legend, Ernie Ball, who also played in that first Masters, was subsequently the golf professional at Oak Park CC for 25 years.

Our Better-Ball of Pairs tournament will be played at Edgewood Valley Country Club on Monday, June 20th. Edgewood Valley was founded in 1910. In 1926 it was moved to its current location in south Willow Springs Road in La Grange, IL. Designed by William Diddle, a very well known course designer during that era, significant efforts have been made over the years to maintain the unique design features Mr. Diddle originally installed.

In 2006 the golf course was renovated to lengthen the course and increase the number of bunkers to 104. The course plays longer than its yardage due to the well-bunkered and narrow fairways that wind through the tall oak trees on the course. Players will also be challenged by the small and fast greens.

On Thursday, September 8, our Senior Better-Ball of Pairs tournament will be held at Sunset Ridge Country Club in Northfield, IL. Created in 1923 by a group of young men in their thirties and officially opened in 1924, course renovations in 2006 earned Sunset Ridge the 2006 Private Club Golf Course Renovation of the Year by Golf, Inc. magazine. The Clubhouse renovations earned a Club Management Magazine Design Showcase award in 2005. The golf course was recently recognized by Golf Digest magazine as being one of the top 25 courses in Illinois.

Message from the Technology Development Chair



Being on the CWDGA board has given me the opportunity to do something I never thought I would do. I have spent the out-of-golf season

overseeing the modernization of the CWDGA website. Matt Baylor of the CDGA and the CDGA contactor, AppNet, have created all the new tools and gizmos that make our new website so much more useful. Ours is no longer just an information site; we have a website with many new interactive features.

New Home Page, Same Location:

To get to our new Home Page, type www.cwdga.org into the address field of your browser. We have an Announcements section that will provide current information, directing you to updates in the website. The Registration Center under the Announcements will direct you to events with open registration. And the photo section on the right will be filled with photos of our players and tournaments as the season progresses.

A word about browsers. I have learned that there is HTML that works well on Internet Explorer and then there is everything else. Our website looks great on Internet Explorer. We still look pretty good on Google Chrome and Mozilla Firefox. We are still useable on Apple's Safari, but many boxes overlap and we look goofy. If things look goofy, no worries: all the processes still work.

How to Log in: To get the most out of our website, please login using your CDGA My Caddie ID and password. If you have never registered with the CDGA, you can register on our home page by clicking on SIGN IN/REGISTER and following the directions provided. You will need your CDGA number

which you can get from either your handicap card, handicap reports at your club or your pro shop.

My Account: Once you log in, you are directed to a page filled with information about you. Here you can change your address, email or phone number, see your handicap details and see which tournaments you have signed up for.

My favorite new feature - register for tournaments. Once you've logged in, you can turn to the most fun new feature: the capability to register online for tournaments and meetings, and pay online as well. For example, if you wanted to play in the One-Day Stroke Play event, you would click on the Tournaments tab. From the drop down menu, select Tournament Schedule and, voila, you can see all the tournaments we are hosting this year. Click on One-Day Stroke Play to see more information about the May 25th event at Oak Park Country Club. If you decide to register, then click on Online Entry and follow the steps from there.

Also register for meetings:

Under the **Calendar** tab, you'll see Meetings and Rules Seminar. Those links will take you to registrations for the Spring Meeting and Rules Seminar respectively. If you click on the calendar tab, you'll see a list of all of the events planned for 2011.

Four-Ball Team Play: The Four-Ball tab provides many features of interest to team captains and players. There is a list of clubs by section, the schedule of matches, "Instructions Governing Four-Ball Match Play" the schedule of team captains' meetings and the informational "Captains' Responsibilities." As the season progresses, we'll be posting results under this same tab.

Rules: This tab has information on the Rules Seminar and online registration, rules for tournament players and four-ball players, a Rule-of-the-month and Rules Quiz and "Instructions for Rules Chairs." For a chuckle, see the "Original 13 Rules of Golf" page. Our sport has a long and dignified history.

Informational Tabs: The remaining tabs are chock full of information you might be interested in.

Under the **Home** tab you can find Forms and Reports with things as varied as the 2010 Annual Report, the Four-Ball Match Play Permanent Replacement Form, the Hole-In-One Award form and the CWDGA Constitution.

Under **Membership**, you might be interested in the member club feature that allows you to find the Glen Oak Pro (Danny Mulhearn) or Glen Oak Team Captain (Christine Malmgren) pretty easily.

Under **About CWDGA** you'll find our Board of Directors listed. If you click on any board member's name, you can send her an email. It's that easy.

And finally there's the **Handicap** tab with information about handicap revision dates, equitable stroke control and links to other handicap resources.



Tee Time Trivia

OLYMPIA FIELDS COUNTRY CLUB TO HOST 2011 U.S. GIRLS' JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Olympia Fields Country Club has been selected by the United States Golf Association as the site of the 2011 **U.S. Girls' Junior Championship**, to be played July 18-23.

The Girls' Junior will be contested over the South Course at Olympia Fields, a 1915 Tom Bendelow design which recently underwent a major restoration by Steve Smyers Golf Course Architects. The South is one of two courses at Olympia Fields. Its North Course, designed by Willie Park and opened in 1923, was the site of three previous USGA championships: the 1928 U.S. Open (won by Johnny Farrell), the 1997 U.S. Senior Open (won by Graham Marsh) and the 2003 U.S. Open (won by Jim Furyk). It also hosted the 1925 and 1961 PGA Championships.

The U.S. Girls' Junior Championship is one of four championships to be played at Olympia Fields over the next three years, including the 2010 Illinois PGA Section Championship, the 2012 Junior Ryder Cup and the 2013 Western Amateur.

World Golf Hall of Fame and honorary Olympia Fields Country Club member Carol Mann will serve as the honorary chairwoman of the 2011 U.S. Girls' Junior Championship.

First contested in 1949, the U.S. Girls' Junior is open to female golfers who have not reached their 18th birthday and have a USGA Handicap Index® that does not exceed 18.4.
